Chemin Blanc 2011 Seabrook, Western Cape, South Africa.	£4.25	£12.20	£16.95

Crisp, zesty and full of fruit. From cool vineyards in the mountains north of Cape Town.

Verdejo Canto Real, Rueda, Spain.	£4.50	£12.95	£18.00
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If you fancy a change from Sauvignon Blanc but like the fruity, fresh, zesty character you get, look no further than Verdejo from Rueda.

Picpoul de Pinet 2011, Domaine des Lauriers, Languedoc, France.	£5.65	£16.20	£22.50
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Crisp with floral and fruit flavours. Vines grow near the famous Etang de Thau oyster beds.

Petit Chablis 2011 Domaine de la Meuliere, Burgundy, France.	£8.00	£23.00	£32.00
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How many people love Chablis but hate Chardonnay? The success of Chablis is the fact that this Chardonnay based wine is particularly crisp with floral and mineral characters.

Sancerre 2011 Domain Yves Martin, Chavignol, Loire, France.	£9.80	£28.00	£39.00
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Quintessential Sauvignon Blanc; cut grass, gooseberries and black currant leaves. Great with seafood.

Albarino 2011 Abadia de San Campio, Rias, Baixas, Spain.	£10.50	£29.50	£41.00
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The maritime climate means that the Albarino grape benefits from the cooling influence of the Atlantic Ocean, allowing a vivacious acidity and primary fruit flavours. The wine has intense aromatic nose of citrus fruits with delicate floral undertones.

Gros Plant du Pays 2009 Nantais	£5.15	£14.50	£21.95
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A very dry, light wine with a degree of sharpness. It is the perfect wine with oysters and all shellfish. Specially selected and bottled under the *Loch Fyne* label.

<u>SPARKLING</u> Prosecco dei Colli Trevigiani Donna Trevigianna, Veneto Brut, Frizzante, Italy	£7.30	£20.90	£28.95
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Delicious sparkling wine from the north east of Italy. Delicate elderflower and apple flavours.

Another example of the potential of the Cape's vineyards with notes of cherry, cassis and plum.

Rioja 2011 Dominio de Heredia, Spain	£5.65	£16.20	£22.50
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Made by one of the best producers in Rioja Alta, this smooth Tempranillo is bursting with jammy flavours and soft cinnamon spices.

Malbec Organic 2011 Santa Julia, Mendoza, Argentina	£6.30	£18.00	£25.00
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Typical Malbec displaying delicious spices and plum characters.

Pinot Noir 2010 Insight, Marlborough, New Zealand.	£9.80	£28.00	£39.00
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This is what Marlborough does best - a gloriously perfumed, big fruit bomb of a wine. It is totally seductive and completely irresistible.

Nathaniel Johnston Reserve Claret	£5.35	£15.00	£22.95
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From a family of Scots who settled in Bordeaux in the early 1700's, it is made from Merlot and Cabernet grapes in a very fresh fruity style.

<u>ROSE WINE</u> Tempranillo Rosado 2011 Vacceos, Rueda, Spain.	£4.90	£14.00	£19.50
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Catapult yourself into summer. A unique and wonderful rose with melon, fresh strawberry, white flowers and a great citrusy zip.

<u>CHAMPAGNE</u> Cuvee Leonie Canard Duchene Brut	£10.00	£28.75	£39.95
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This Cuvee is a tribute to the woman who jointly founded the house in 1868, Leonie Duchene. It is stylish and has a lovely toasted brioche, peach and cream flavour with a fresh finish.
