

Champagnes

25. Collet NV Brut, France – £39.25

A warm golden colour with an intense, almost amber hue. On the palate a fresh buttery and ripe rich flavours that is powerful and robust.

26. Collet NV Rose, France - £47.75

A wonderful colour with a delightful, fruit filled nose reminiscent of strawberries and raspberries, which also appear on the palate..

27. Veuve Clicquot Brut NV, French - £43.75

Veuve Clicquot ages their non-vintage for almost twice the required time, resulting in a superb marriage of freshness and power, with rich fruit and a mouth-filling mousse.

28. Veuve Clicquot Rose, French - £52.00

A relatively recent addition to the Veuve Clicquot stable, this medium bodied rose is reminiscent of the power and finesse of the non-vintage label, with a soft redfruit core.

29. Laurent Perrier NV Rosé - Champagne - £89.00

An attractive and delicate pink Champagne, with a lovely pale salmon colour and delightful creamy strawberry and raspberry fruits.

30. Bollinger Special Cuvée Brut NV – Champagne - £60.00

Lovely classy, intense nose shows savoury bready notes and a touch of lifted acidity, with a complex toasty edge.

31. Dom Perignon Vintage Brut – Champagne - £159.75

Regarded as the pinnacle of excellence. An intensely flavoured Champagne, displaying tropical fruit, berry and citrus flavours and aromas, ending with an aftertaste of dried fruit.

32. Krug Grande Cuvée – Champagne - £167.50

Krug Grande Cuvée is the timelessly stylish signature of Krug, a breath-taking Champagne that effortlessly balances richness and freshness, power and finesse.

33. Krug Rose Brut – Champagne - £253.35

The NV Brut Rose is awesome in the way it combines elegance, finesse and power. There is superb material in the density of fruit, along with perfumed aromatics and silky, chalky tannins that frame the long finish. It's all here in this sublime, sensual wine, but readers should note that the same caveats apply as with the Grand Cuvée above.

Port

34. Taylor's LBV - 50ml Glass £2.20

Concentrated fruity flavour and firm, full-bodied style make Taylor's LBV the perfect port to accompany chocolate desserts and blue cheeses.

35. Krohn 1963 Cohletia - 50ml Glass £6.35

Why not treat yourself to a glass of this exceptional, gold-medal-winning vintage Tawny Port. Complex Xmas-cake flavours, staggering length and balance.

White Wines

1. Baron d'Arignac, France - £13.95

The Baron d'Arignac wines are very popular and are a great example of the quality wines from France. The medium sweet is packed with fruit and is popular for those who prefer a wine that is not bone dry.

2. Bello Tramonto Pinot Grigio, Italy - £17.50

Straw yellow in appearance, this generous, well balanced Pinot Grigio has a rich and fruit aroma. Light bodied, this wine is dry and crisp with a smooth fruity taste.

3. Grove Mill Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, New Zealand - £24.95

An elegant blend of tropical overtones, passion fruit, gooseberries, kiwi fruit with hints of herbal notes. Full palate weight with balanced structure and a crisp, clean finish. Intense flavours of pineapple, grapefruit, white peach and gooseberry.

4. Domaine de la Motte, Chablis Vieilles Vignes, Burgundy, France - £34.75

One of the best known villages of northern Burgundy, Chablis is made from 100% Chardonnay grapes. The Chablis Vieilles Vignes from le Domaine de la Motte is produced with 40 year-old vines. The lower yields allow the aromas to be fuller and the roundness in the mouth -exceptional.

5. Nepenthe Chardonnay, Adelaide Hills, Australia - £18.25

A dry, clean wine with crisp acidity and an excellent vanilla nose. Pronounced fruit on the palate with buttery tones. Well-balanced and appealing wine.

6. Via Alta Sauvignon Blanc, Central Valley, Chile - £15.50

A fresh, zesty Sauvignon Blanc. Fermented in stainless steel and bottled young to capture the natural aromatic characteristics and acidity which is typical for this variety.

7. Goldfields Semillon/Chardonnay, South Eastern Australia - £16.25

Straw yellow colour with a green tinge. The aroma have a spectrum of citrus and apples complemented with hints of stone fruit. A refreshing light wine with lemony peach characters, finishing fresh and crisp.

8. Sancerre Domaine de Durand, France - £32.75

Flinty and fruity, from the Sauvignon grape. Wonderful nose, with all the classic flavours that follows. This wine is from a small producer who emphasis the quality.

9. Vallet Frères Auxey Duresses, Burgundy, France - £62.25

One of Burgundy's top producers, Bernard Vallet creates a wine of exquisite complex butterscotch and citrus aromas that are matched by full tropical fruits on the palate and beautifully balanced acidity.

10. Cloudy Bay Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, New Zealand - £49.25

World famous Sauvignon Blanc that is bursting with passion fruit, gooseberry and elderflower tones, its zesty palate is mouth-wateringly refreshing.

Rosé Wines

11. White Rose, Zinfandel Rose, California - £16.25

A delicious, medium-sweet Rosé made from Zinfandel grapes grown in the Lodi Region east of San Francisco. The wine is only allowed a short maceration on the skins to impart the beautiful salmon-pink colour, and then cool-fermented to retain its freshness. .

12. Faustino Rivero Rosado – Rioja, Spain - £18.25

Intense bouquet of strawberries, raspberries and redcurrants. A pronounced flowery character. Deliciously rich in the mouth with fleshy fruit flavours that are full and luscious.

13. Bello Tramonto Pinot Grigio Rose – Italy - £16.25

This elegant Pinot Grigio displays delicious strawberry fruit aromas with a crisp fresh finish

Red Wines

14. Viala Sangiovese, Italy - £17.15

A tremendously fruity wine that is soft, approachable, easy drinking and bursting with red berry fruit flavours.

15. Bodegas Ramon Bilbao Gran Reserva, Rioja, Spain - £34.75

An outstanding mature Rioja, with hints of blackcurrant fruit on the nose. The wines extended ageing with oak barrels has imparted a wonderful rich vanilla oak character.

16. Via Alta Merlot, Central Valley, Chile - £16.00

Uncomplicated and easy-drinking.....Silky smooth and packed full of soft, juicy plum and blackcurrant fruit flavours, with a warm peppery finish.

17. A Few Good Men Pinotage , South Africa - £23.15

Rich flavours of fruitcake and ripe plum that follow through in a seductive palate with a smooth juicy finish.

18. Savigny Les Beune Les Gollarde, France - £41.55

This elegant perfumes Savigny preserves the complex raspberry fruit flavours, distinct mineral character and power inherited from the iron rich soil.

19. Chianti Colli Senesi Poggio Cavall, Italy- £25.75

A modern style of Chianti with ripe and vibrant fresh fruit, a touch of oak from a brief maturation in barrel and a typical bittersweet finish.

20. Pierre Bourée , Côte de Beaune Villages, Burgundy, France - £41.55

A fine Burgundy produced by traditional methods - authenticity is key to the quality here.

21. Los Gansos Pinot Noir, Chile - £17.25

Aromas of berries, black cherries and sweet fruits mix with hints of toasty oak. Fine tannins give rich texture in the mouth.

22. Poker Face, Cabernet Merlot, Australia - £25.75

A blend of two excellent grape varieties. Cabernet Sauvignon provides the palate weight & the fresh berry flavours. The merlot softens the palate superbly.

20. Terrazas Reserva Malbec, Argentina - £28.75

Profound and deep violet red in colour. Brimming with red fruit, cherries, sour cherries, dry plums, raisins and permeated by delicate floral scents (violet) and touches of toasted vanilla and caramel.

21. Villa Martis, Marques de Gresi, Piedmont, Italy - £45.50

A complex and elegant blend of Nebbiolo and Barbera grapes from one of Northern Italy's greatest vineyards.

22. Châteauneuf-du-Pape Domaine Chante Cigale, Rhone, France - £51.50

This complex wine has warm red spicy fruit and damson aromas, dense dark cherry fruit on the palate; structure, richness and a touch of elegance at the finish.

Sparkling Wines

23. Prosecco Emotivo – Italy - £23.00

This classic Prosecco has a bright straw colour with lively aromas of intense vine fruits. Naturally balanced and graceful with a fresh effervescence and a velvety smoothness and harmonious finish.

24. Emotivo Sparking Rosé – Italy - £26.50

A delicious sparkling rose with soft strawberry fruit aromas with a clean refreshing finish.
