Champagne and Sparkling

1. **NV Prosecco Brut, Stelle d'Italia, Veneto, Italy** £21.00
A lively, crisp sparkling wine with a delicate lemon character and an aromatic, dry, refreshing finish.
2. **Aurora Rose, Ponte, Italy NV** £23.00
Cherry pink in colour with aromas of strawberries and the taste of summer.
3. **Champagne Marie Demets Brut NV** £34.00
From a small, family-owned Champagne house in the Aube region famed for its Pinot Noir, this is refreshing and elegant, with vibrant orange and lime blossom flavours and gently biscuity notes. A perfect example of an elegant Champagne best enjoyed with fish or on its own as an aperitif.
4. **Billecart-Salmon Brut Reserve NV** £40.95
Delicate, yet flavoured. Billecart's fine textural weave vigorously unspools into filaments of tiny brilliant bubbles.
5. **Billecart-Salmon Rosé NV** £65.00
Small additions of still Pinot Noir add extra dimensions of colour and flavour, without ever compromising the gentle impact of the underlying blend.
6. **Champagne Le Mesnil Cuvée Prestige Grand Cru, 2004** £62.50
This is as close to perfection as you can get – made purely from Chardonnay grapes in an excellent vintage from 40 year old vines situated in the top south-facing vineyards in Champagne, it offers tantalising aromas of peach, white flour and toasty brioche, with a rich, creamy texture and a finish that lingers long after the first sip. Irresistible.
7. **Bollinger Special Cuvée NV** £52.00
Rich, toasty and full bodied, with wonderful concentration and depth of flavour.
8. **Veuve Clicquot Brut Yellow Label NV** £59.00
A full, dry, rounded Champagne.

White Wines

Floral, Zesty and Fruity

9. **Sauvignon Blanc, Santa Luz, Chile 2011** £16.50
Super sleek, passion-fruit-scented Sauvignon.
10. **St Jean, Vin de Pays de Cotes de Gascogne, France 2010** £14.95
Slimline and sophisticated.
11. **Riesling, Reichsat Von Buhl, Pfalz, Germany 2011** £21.00
Bright and lively with distinctive aromas of fresh peach and apricot, with some harder notes of minerality. Full and intense on the palate with the same fruits. Good length with a vibrant, precise finish of fresh grapefruit.
12. **Pinot Grigio, Gargonaga Via Nova, Italy 2011** £17.50
Dry and medium bodied with apple and pear fruit flavours, citrus acidity and hints of almond.
13. **Basa, Telmo Rodriguez, Rueda, Spain 2010** £18.95
Telmo blends a little Sauvignon in with the local Verdejo grape, and the result is subtly unconventional.

Rich, Soft and Mellow

14. **Reserve Chardonnay, Tooma River, Warburn Estate, South Eastern Australia 2011** £17.95
Packed with grapefruit, lime and melon flavours all bound up with a zesty, crisp, citrus balance which cuts through to the finish.


15. **Petit Chenin, Ken Forrester, Stellenbosch, South Africa 2011** £17.95
Supple and spicy Chenin Blanc with a steely edge.
16. **Chablis Domaine Vrignaud, Burgundy 2010** £26.50
The muted tones of cool-grown Chardonnay bring Chablis' jostling mineral nature to the fore.
17. **Vernaccia di San Gimignano, Riccardo Falchini, Italy 2009/11** £21.50
There is life beyond Pinot Grigio! A pure, elegant and mineral wine – hints of lemon oil, almonds and lime fruit on the palate, while the characteristic salty tang comes through on the finish. This is lovely.
18. **Chassagne Montrachet, Phillipe Colin, Burgundy 2009** £59.50
Congested planting liberates aromas of barley and flint from Chassagne's rock-strewn earth.
19. **Picpoul de Pinet, Domaine Félines-Jourdan, Coteaux du Languedoc 2010/11** £22.50
Round and weighty, but fresh with grapefruit, pear and fennel aromas and hints of white pepper spice.

Full and Aromatic

20. **Gruner Veltliner, von den Terrassen, Ehmoser, Austria 2009/11** £19.75
Firm, powerful and deeply infused with spice.
21. **Sancerre, Daniel Chotard, Loire 2010** £29.95
Chotard expertly sacrifices a little Sauvignon "pungency" in order to boost his wine's tactile thrill.
22. **Silver Lake Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, New Zealand 2011** £23.95
This wine is changing to Silver Lake Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, New Zealand 2011. From the Villa Maria estate, fresh and zesty with ripe gooseberry fruit and a crisp finish.
23. **Saint Véran, Domaine des Valanges 2011** £29.95
An elegant, unoaked Chardonnay, with a subtle minerality and lovely citrus fruit. A beautifully balanced wine.
24. **Viognier, Vin de Pays d'Oc, Domaine Fontareche 2011** £19.95
Viognier is noted for its aromatic character and this example from the south of France does not disappoint – beautiful aromas of white flowers, peach, apricot and honey draw you in to enjoy the rich, punchy fruit flavours and long, crisp finish.
25. **Tierhoek, Sauvignon Blanc, Piekeniersloof, South Africa 2009** £24.95
From the second highest vineyards in the Cape, this is an elegant and refined Sauvignon Blanc, with subtle flavours of blackberry leaf and passion fruit, balanced with a fresh minerality.
26. **"Terroirs des Chateaux Forts" Rolly-Gassmann, Alsace 2006/10** £24.50
Alsace is something of an invisible oasis, quenching the thirsts of knowledgeable wine drinkers, but remains unseen by most. Rich, honeyed and evolved.

Rosé

27. **St Jean, Vin de Pays d'Oc, France 2008** £14.95
Delicate and fruity, without the distraction of deep colour and tannin.
28. **Malbec Rosé, Bodegas, Santa Ana, Spain 2011** £19.95
Fresh and aromatic with a crisp, fruit driven palate and a dry finish.

Soft and Fruity

29. **St Jean, Vin de Pays d'Oc, France 2009** £14.95
Blissfully simple blend
30. **Beaujolais Villages, Louis Tête, Burgundy, France 2010** £23.95
An elegant, fresh intense nose of soft red fruits. The palate has lots of fruit with plenty of character backed by good balancing acidity.
31. **Umoro Nero, Pinot Noir, Oltrepò Pavese, Castello di Luzzano, Italy 2010** £24.95
A fresh, floral wine packed with pure raspberry fruit. A very elegant, juicy attractive wine.

Hearty and Aromatic

32. **La Garenne Syrah, IGP Pays d'Oc, Languedoc Roussillon, France 2011** £15.95
Cherry and pepper flavours are offset by the wine's meaty and bitter chocolate aromas.
33. **Cabernet Sauvignon, les Fleurs du Sud Vin de Pays d'Oc, France 2009** £14.95
Rich and satisfying with an undertow of ripe black fruits.
34. **Petit Cabernet Merlot, Ken Forrester, Stellenbosch, South Africa 2011** £17.95
A youthful, fresh Bordeaux-styled blend showing plums and spiciness. Very accessible with a smooth and balanced texture.
35. **Pirita Arribes del Duero, Spain 2009** £34.50
Old vines whipped-up into something special by an Old Stamfordian.
36. **Merlot, Santa Luz, Chile 2010** £16.50
Gritty, warm and easy.
37. **Reserve Shiraz, Tooma River, Warburn Estate, South Eastern Australia 2011** £17.95
A rich nose redolent with red and black berry aromas and a smooth, textured palate dripping with juicy dark fruits, hints of chocolate and lively spices.
38. **Château du Pavillon, Cannon-Fronsac, Bordeaux 2006** £29.95
Black fruits and cedar.
39. **Crozes Hermitage, Domaine Remizieres, Rhône 2010** £28.95
Dark infusion of fruit, spice and earth.
40. **Les Chamans, La Livinière, Minervois 2006** £25.00
Chamans' delicious organic red restores old ties with the Earth.
41. **Chianti, Colli Senesi Riccardo Falchini, Italy 2009** £25.00
Cherry and herb-scented Sangiovese from Tuscany's handsomely ravaged hills.

Velvety and Round

42. **Paternina, Banda Azul Rioja Crianza, Spain 2007** £21.50
A traditional Rioja with soft redcurrant and vanilla oak on the nose and palate.
43. **Unravalled Pinot Noir, Carrick Winery, Central Otago, New Zealand 2011** £29.95
Ripe berries and black cherries on the nose which transfer onto the palate with a hint of oak. Finely balanced, fruit forward styled wine.
44. **Lammershoek, Pinotage, Swartland, South Africa 2007** £32.50
A very appealing rounded fruit driven Pinotage with a refreshing earthiness on the finish.
45. **Visan-Cotes du Rhône 'Nature' Domaine de Fourmente 2010** £22.50
Unctuously lubricating Grenache-based blend.
46. **Hautes Côte de Nuits, Domaine Beutagna, 2008** £25.00
Pure and delicate, with the autumnal fragrance of sweet, leafy loam.
47. **Silver Lake Merlot/Malbec, Hawkes Bay, New Zealand 2010** £23.95
From the Villa Maria estate, youthful plum and berry fruit dominate this mid-bodied red.

Rounded and Elegant

48. **Quoin Rock Syrah, Simonsberg, Stellenbosch, South Africa 2006** £29.50
A rich, powerful but elegant wine dominated by ripe black fruits, with a hint of dark chocolate, spice and vanilla. It is pure and beautifully balanced with soft tannins and a refreshing minerality – drinking superbly now.
49. **Châteauneuf du Pape Tradition, Domaine La Boutinière 2008** £45.00
This is undoubtedly by far the best value Châteauneuf on the market – spice, plum and strawberry fruit dominate, while the finish is elegant and beautifully balanced, with delicate herbal notes. Frederic made just one cuvee in 2008, so the wine benefits from all of the best grapes, these being a blend of Grenache, Syrah, Cinsault and Mourvèdre. What's more, it is drinking superbly now, unlike Châteauneuf du Papes from much riper, hotter vintages.
50. **Malbec Cabernet Sauvignon Corte C. Vistalba, Mendoza, Argentina 2010** £23.95
A deeply coloured full bodied red with great concentration of blackberry fruit.

Fortified and Dessert Wine

51. **MR, Malaga 2006** 50cl bottle £15.95
Lustrous, oozing, Moscatel. 125ml £4.50
52. **Château de Cérons, Cérons 1998** half bottle £22.00
Sweet, honeyed and persistent.
53. **Quinta do Passadouro LBV Port, Portugal 2005** £27.00
Douro, Portugal (19% abv) 70ml £4.50
Slowly born out of the dark morass of grape-must and alcohol, Port remains one of the World's great wines.
