Terre Cortesi, Marche Bianco. Italy

Apples & limes on the palate, crisp and clean finish. A simple and easy drinking white.

Vellas Vellas, Sauvignon Blanc. Chile

A fresh and zesty Sauvignon with concentrated aromas of mango, pineapple and limes.

Colombard, VdP Cotes de Gascogne. France

This is for all you Sauvignon drinkers who want a change. It has all the crisp, fruity drive that you like, but the finish is more elegant and less intense.

Pinot Grigio San Vito. Italy

Textbook wine. Clean, fresh & dry with a hit of green apples and pears, touch of minerality.

Vavasour, Sauvignon Blanc. New Zealand

Bronze Medal from Decanter, it epitomises what Sauvignon is about. Clean, fresh, zingy, vibrant and that lovely gooseberry nose. Cloudy Bay look out.

Maiden Flight Riesling Reserva, Bio Bio Valley. Chile

Yes, there really is a Bio Bio Valley in Chile! From the south comes this drop dead gorgeous, clean, vibrant and zingy white. No sugar, just bags of flavour and character.

Pinot Gris AC 2009. Domaine Frederic Mochel. France

Drank this at a Michelin starred restaurant recently and it bowled us over! Clean, subtle hint of spice yet leaving a powerful crisp finish. It really is a stunner.

Medium bodied with fruitiness

Tierra Antica Chardonnay. Chile

Lively and vibrant, tropical overtones, soft and easy drinking, not too muck oak.

Alto Pampas, Viognier. Mendoza, Argentina

Very ripe apricots are the lead nose here. Loads of sunshine gives a full and flavoursome body to the wine. Viognier at this price is a steal!

Gewurztraminer Cave de Turckheim. France

Put aside any prejudices and give this wine a go. Intense and floral on the nose, yet the finish is sharp and aromatic. Perfect with spicy foods.

Frascati Superiore, Cantine San Marco. Italy

Understated, yet very elegant, this wine has a light golden hue with soft fruity aromas. Like all things Italian it is charming and elegant. Bellissimo!

Picpoul de Pinet. Languedoc, France

Not dissimilar in style to a Muscadet, this lively southern French number is the perfect partner to anything fishy. Clean and invigorating, it slips down a treat.

Echeverria Chardonnay. Chile

This wine is for those of you who want something big & bold! A hit of ripe peaches and bananas, topped up with oak & toffee. Chardonnay from days gone by.

Macon-Vergisson, La Roche, Nadine et Maurice Guerrin. France

Wow, we really like this one. Burgundy, punching well above its weight. Good bit of minerality, with a touch of yeastiness. If this were Chablis, you would be paying double!

Greco di Tufo, Loggia della Serra. Italy

Italy, inland from Naples. Greco is the grape which gives a smoky almond aroma, the flavours are of sugary grapefruits. This is a big, grown up wine.

Chablis Les Valery. France

Classically elegant - steely, minerally and flinty. This is what Chablis is all about. Enjoy it.

Rosé

Pinot Grigio delle Venezie Blush, Sentito. Italy

What you want in a rosé, clean summer fruits, nose of strawberries, hint of sweetness and very easy to drink! This has it in bucket loads.

Bois des Violettes, Languedoc. France

Not a blush, but a proper rosé, with real purpose. Not as sweet as the Italian above, but a lot more strawberries and cream. This is what our terrace and garden was made for!

Mas Amor, Rosado. Spain

OMG - this is possibly the tastiest rosé we have ever tried! Zingy fruit flavours, brilliant hue and a perfectly rounded finish. It also boasts a 'Banksy' arty style label.

Chateau du Galoupet. Cotes de Provence. France

The benchmark rosé producing area. This is Cru Classe wine. The nose is soft and floral, the palate of cherries and raspberries leads to an elegant and fruity finish. Absolutely stunning!

House Champagne - J De Telmont

As with most fizz, this is a blend of Chardonnay & Pinot Noir. Medium bodied with good soft fruits and a classic yeasty style. Terrific value for money.

Classy Champagne house. Their wines are highly regarded around the world. The pink is sublime, a hint of blackcurrant with an elegant softness in the finish. A charming fizz.

Pouilly Fuisse, Vieille Vignes 2006. Chateau de Fuisse

The flagship wine from the iconic producer of Pouilly Fuisse. Low yielding chardonnay, with massive hits of minerality, naturally creamy fruit and a hint of smoke & oak. Well balanced with a pronounced lengthy finish.

Pampas. Shiraz / Malbec. Argentina

Just what you want from your house wine, a great blend which gives a full, meaty yet rounded wine with a touch of plums and leather.

Vina Edmara, Pinot Noir. Chile

Perfect lighter wine. Soft garnet hue, with a hint of chocolate and a delicate spicy edge to the finish. A very pleasing number.

La Jeanette, Ventoux. France

Grenache & Syrah are the blends, the finished article has strawberries with a hint of pepper and light supple tannins. The French are masters of the blend.

Rockburn. Pinot Noir. New Zealand

Central Otago is where some of the finest Pinot Noir's are coming from at the moment. Rich spicy overtones, hint of liquorice, silky tannins and a touch of chocolate. Truly fantastic.

Medium bodied and stylish

Pleno Tempranillo, Navarra. Spain

Entry level 'Rioja style'. All the same characteristics, oak, smoke and fruit without the price.

Flor del Fuego, Cabernet Sauvignon. Chile

A highly concentrated wine with lots of blue and blackberry fruits, leaving you with a lovely vibrant mouthfull of wine.

Tierra Antica, Merlot. Chile

Cherries & blackberries with a hint of spicy bay leaf - it says on the label, we think it has bags of that along with a hint of plums! Great value red.

Chateau la Grave Singalier, Bordeaux Superieur. France

200 yards further south and this wine would be classed as a Graves, it isn't and we have a soft cedar influenced red, without the higher price!! This is what all good Bordeaux are about.

Montepulciano d'abruzzo D.O.C. Italy

This is a great sharing number, good with food or on its own. As with a lot of Italian wines it has soft tannins and a juicy rich finish. Perfect for summer.

Vina Eguia, Rioja. Spain

What you want a Rioja to be- oaky, vanilla, smoky blackcurrants, soft and velvety with a smooth lingering finish. This is keenly priced because we bought loads of it! You will love this red.

Tanners Claret, Bordeaux. France

Tanners have imported this classic blend for years. 65% Merlot goes in there, which gives a much softer Claret than most. Really easy drinking, perfect with our steak.

Domaine Coston, Pays St Guilhem le Desert. France

Grown on the chalky slopes of Puechabon, 40 miles from Montpellier. What we are getting here is a cracking blended red. Bit of cherry and pepper with a touch of spice.

Big hitting and spicy

Berton Vineyards, Boundary Line Shiraz. Australia

Shiraz is always a top selling red. This is not too jammy, yet has a lovely smooth finish with heaps of berries and spicy blackcurrants.

El Camino Malbec. Argentina

Malbec, rich and smooth with a soft edge. That was our tasting note, what we did not put was bags of fruit with a warm pleasing finish.

Porcupine Ridge, Boekenhoutskloof - Shiraz Viognier. South Africa

These grapes if blended in France would give us Cote Roti at twice the price! Here the blend gives us spice from one and perfume from the other. Trust us, this is good.

Rioja Vina Zaca. Spain

At last, an entry level Rioja with some spirit! Deep, bright red cherry colour with a persistent aroma of ripe fruit and red berries. Superb lengthy finish.

Cotes de Ventoux, Martinelle. France

Wolf in sheep's clothing! This is a Rhone Village from Beaumes des Venise. Brilliantly balanced with a hint of licquorice. Have this when you are not sure what you want, a real crowd pleaser.

Cotes du Rhone, Domaine Charvin. France

Everything that you want from a Rhone red - bags of blackcurranty fruitiness, heaps of spice and some rich tannins to finish it off! Tres superb.

Terra Barossa, Shiraz. Australia

Blimey cobber, a bit of a stonker! As with all things from Oz, lots of everything, fruit, spice and flavour. Deep inky purple in colour with a rich raspberry and chocolate finish.

Chateau De Rieux, Minervois. France

Delicious organic wine with intense blackberry fruit, meaty spice and a very fresh edge. It has a rustic side to it but it is more refined than most.

29.00

Chateauneuf-du-Pape. 2009. Domaine de Ferrand

This is a powerful, yet softly structured Châteauneuf. Juicy blackcurrant and blueberry flavours fill the mouth with aromas of leather and the nose is filled with a hint of Provencale herbs. Good heady stuff!

Chateau Famaey, Cuvee X. France

Malbec, Malbec and yet more Malbec! This is the only grape that these Flemish winemakers work with. Matured in new French oak barriques for 24 months, it imparts a lingering velvetiness and elegance, with aromatic black fruits and tannins.
