1. **Los Pastos Sauvignon Blanc** (Chile)
Lovely, herbaceous, tropical fruit flavours with refreshing balancing acidity.
2. **Los Pastos Chardonnay** (Chile)
Smooth and satisfying with ripe peach and pineapple flavours and a hint of creamy richness.
3. **Los Pastos Merlot** (Chile)
Soft with succulent berry and damson flavours and a pleasing hint of cinnamon spice.

White Wines

4. **Cape 312 Chenin Blanc** (South Africa)
Balanced, elegant, medium bodied wine with smooth fruit and soft refreshing acidity representing outstanding value.

5. **Umbrele Sauvignon Blanc** (Romania)
Flavours consistent with those that make Sauvignon Blanc popular the world over. Attractive on its own or with food by the bottle or by the glass.
6. **Tahbilk Little Rascal Chardonnay** (Australia)
Flavours of mango and pear on the nose, and citrus acidity on the palate with a touch of mineral on the finish.
7. **Sauvignon de Touraine, Chéreau Carré** (Loire)
Crisp, fruity Sauvignon with a clean, fresh flavour. This lively wine offers Sauvignon Blanc of real value.
8. **Terre al Lago Pinot Grigio** (Italy)
A premium Pinot Grigio with a large helping of creamy, tropical fruits, spicy and aromatic in the mouth and a lively finish.

9. **Babich Marlborough Black Label Sauvignon Blanc** (New Zealand)
Classy Sauvignon from a long established family estate. Intense aromas and flavours showing ripe gooseberry fruit with a long, crisp finish.
10. **Sancerre Les Cailloux Blancs, Chéreau Carré** (Loire)
Superb accompaniment to fish, chicken or Brie. Great depth of citrus fruit flavours, slightly aromatic in the mouth with balancing soft acidity.

Rose Wines

11. **Los Pastos Merlot Rosé** (Chile)
Stylish with good red berry fruit feel and soft refreshing acidity.

12. **Pacific Heights Zinfandel Blush** (California)
This is a popular medium style of Blush that is bursting with succulent strawberries and cream fruit flavours.

Red Wines

13. **The Landings Shiraz Cabernet** (Australia)
The spicy Shiraz fruit blends perfectly with the bramble and blackcurrant concentration of the Cabernet.

14. **Los Espinos Merlot** (Chile)
Black cherry and bramble scented with a smooth and weighty palate.
15. **Lark's Ridge Cabernet Sauvignon** (Chile)
Fresh and deep flavoured red with good depth of flavour.
16. **Chianti Vernaiolo, Rocca delle Macie** (Italy)
Made using modern fermentation methods to maximise the fruit flavours from the grape skins, this DOCG wine is expertly made by this now iconic producer who has a passion for quality. Distinctive Sangiovese fruit, great body, length and complexity.

17. **Grant Burge Shiraz GB56** (Australia) D **£16.95**
Deep Shiraz colour with aromas of black pepper and spice. Flavours of both red and black fruits complemented by careful use of oak to give a long finish.
18. **Niel Joubert Pinotage** (South Africa) D **£17.95**
The signature red grape of South Africa. Tantalising aroma with intense colour and bold berry flavour. This wine is beautifully balanced with soft tannins.
19. **Brindisi, Cantine due Palma** (Italy) C **£18.95**
A velvety smooth red from Puglia with ample body and fruit and a very soft, easy finish.
20. **Babich East Coast Pinot Noir** (New Zealand) B **£19.95**
New Zealand Pinot Noir comes in various styles – this avoids being jammy by having savoury and clean red fruit flavours.
21. **Fleurie Les Roches, Domaine Berrod** (Beaujolais) B **£24.95**
One of the most popular Beaujolais Crus, because it is all that Beaujolais should be, scented, fruity and easy to drink. This is grown on granite soil and produces velvety, elegant and smooth wines.
22. **Coto de Imaz Rioja Reserva** (Spain) D **£29.95**
This is a classic Rioja Reserva. The use of new American oak gives complexity and structure and the integrated tannins give a perfect balance to the wine. Recent Silver Medal Winner at 2011 International Wine Challenge.
23. **Coto de Imaz Rioja Gran Reserva** (Spain) D **£34.95**
A truly great wine. There are only certain years that these top quality Tempranillo grapes mature enough to consider making the Gran Reserva. The grape must be frequently “pumped over” its lees to produce intense, concentrated flavours and then gain further complexity from a long ageing in new American oak. A wine in total harmony with all its constituent parts. Won Gold Medal at 2011 International Wine Challenge.
24. **Chateau Saumur-Champigny Vieilles Vignes** (Loire) C **£36.95**
Charming, fleshy and fruity red with the old vines adding body and concentrated flavour.
25. **Barolo Franco Serra** (Italy) E **£39.95**
The Nebbiolo grape gives the wine great body, character and a rich, majestic style. Deep in colour with a vanilla note and full flavour.

Champagnes

26. **Bortolomiol Prosecco Treviso** (Italy) 2 **£24.95**
Modern and fashionable, this Prosecco is clean, crisp and refreshing with a slight tang of green apples.
27. **Bortolomiol Rosato Frizzante** (Italy) 2A **£24.95**
Crisp and dry, this sparkling wine oozes a concentration of red berry fruits and a refreshing finish.
28. **Moët & Chandon Brut NV** 1 **£49.95**
Still the Champagne brand leader.
29. **Veuve Clicquot Yellow Label Brut NV** 1 **£57.95**
Famous for a long time for its consistent quality and full but biscuity finish.
30. **Laurent Perrier Rosé NV** 1A **£79.95**
The brand leader in Rosé Champagne. Bottled in its distinctive dumpy bottle and well enough made to repay being kept for a year or two.
31. **Dom Perignon Vintage** 1 **£134.95**
Did this famous monk invent Champagne or not? Whatever, the champagne bearing his name is one of the region's best.

TASTE GUIDE

White wines are designated numbers 1 to 5, with 1 being the driest and 5 being the sweetest. Red wines are designated letters A to E, with A being the lightest and E being the deepest and fullest. Rosé wines are a combination of Red and White.
