Distinctive Sangiovese fruit, great body, length and complexity. White wines are designated numbers 1 to 5, with 1 being the driest and 5 being the sweetest. Red wines are designated letters A to E, with A being the lightest and E being the deepest and fullest. Rosé wines are a combination of Red and White.
