Schedule A

- None, but for greater certainty and without restricting the business which the corporation may carry on, the Corporation shall have the following objects:
 - a) to engage in every phase and aspect of rendering the same service to the public that a lawyer, being a member of The Law Society of Alberta, is authorized to render;
 - b) to purchase or otherwise acquire and to own, mortgage, pledge, sell, assign, transfer or otherwise dispose of, and to invest in, deal in and with, real and personal property necessary for the rendering of the services of a lawyer;
 - c) to contract debts and borrow money, issue and sell or pledge bonds, debentures, notes and other evidences of indebtedness and execute such mortgages, transfers of corporate property or other instruments to secure the payment of corporate indebtedness as required; and
 - d) to enter into partnership, consolidate or merge with or purchase the assets of another corporation or individual rendering the same professional services.

Schedule B

The liability of the shareholder(s) is limited as provided in the Business Corporations Act except in the circumstances described in section 133 of the Legal Profession Act, which reads as follows:

133(1) Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in the Business Corporations Act, every person who is a voting shareholder of a corporation during the time that it is the holder of a permit or of a corporation during the time that it acts in contravention of section 106(1) is liable to the same extent and in the same manner as if the voting shareholders of the corporation were during that time carrying on the business of the corporation as a partnership or, if there is only one voting shareholder, as an individual practicing as a barrister and solicitor.
